Churchill

Winston Churchill was born the 30 November 1874 and was dead the 24 January 1965. He won the Nobel Prize in Literature. He was the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom from 1940 to 1945 and again from 1951 to 1955. Born into the aristocratic family of the Dukes of Marlborough, Winston Leonard Spencer-Churchill like is father, used the surname "Churchill" in public life.

He was a politic, historic and British journalist. During the first World War he was Lord Commissioner of the Admiralty. He fought with the army at the front western and command the 6th Battalion of the Royal Scots Fusiliers. He was also Minister of War, Minister of Aviation, Minister of Colonies and Chancellor of the Exchequer. A famous sentence of Churchill was: "He has all the virtues I dislike and none of the vices I admire" refers to a British politician (Sir Stafford Cripps).

The 12th September 1908 he married Clementine Hozier.

Kennedy

John F. Kennedy was born in Massachusetts on May 29th 1917. He attended the Dexter School. After the family moved to New York and he went to a private college. In September 1935 he enrolled to the University of Princeton but he had to drop out of school because of his health problems. A Year Later he went to the Harvard University.

In 1941 he was accepted to the US Navy and during the WWII he took part in some battles in the Pacific Ocean. He later became captain of the PT109 Torpedo Boat. In August 1943 his boat was attacked by the Japanese soldiers and John gathered his crew, becoming a war hero.

After the World War II he became a congressman for nine years. In 1952, he defeated his democratic rival and joined a seat in the US Senate. One year later he married Jacqueline Bouvier. During the '50 his back problems got worst and Kennedy was often absent at the Senate. When his health conditions restored he resumed his political career and in 1960, he ran for President. He won the presidential election and became the 35th US President.

During his presidency John Kennedy faced the Cuban Missile Crises which ended with an agreement with **Nikita Kruscev**. He increased soldiers in Vietnam War. He travelled in Europe and also in West Berlin

He had a lot of speeches all around the Country and during a visit in Dallas, on November 22nd 1963, he got shot and killed by Lee H. Oswald.

Reagan

Ronald Reagan was a politician and an actor, he became the 40th President of United States in 1981. Before the presidency he worked as an actor between 1937 and 1964. In 1949 he met Nancy Davis in a television set, in the 1952 she became Nancy Reagan and in the 1981 she was the first lady of the United States. Between 1967 and 1975 he was the Governor of California, the Republicans were

impressed with Reagan's political views and charisma. In 1976 he started the presidential campaign and he challenged Gerald Ford to become the Republican party's candidate for president, but he lost. In 1980 he started a new presidential campaign and he won against **Jimmy Carter** and John Anderson. On March 30, 1981, Reagan was struck by gunfire from would-be assassin Jr., outside the Washington Hilton Hotel. Reagan died of pneumonia in 2004.
